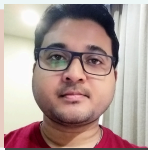

Specifically ragging constitutes any one or more of the following acts (the list is only illustrative):



- (1) Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student
- (2) Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological or physical harm or to raise the fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or any other student
- (3) Asking the students to do or perform any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do, and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student
- (4) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or fresher
- (5) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- (6) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by other students
- (7) Any act of physical abuse including all of its variants, viz, sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping and forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- (8) Any act or abuse by spoken words, e-mails, posts, or public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill, or showing off power, authority or superiority, or passively participating in the discomfiture to any fresher or any other student
- (9) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority over any fresher

**Possible Punishments (one or combination of the following):**



- (1) Cancellation of admission
- (2) Suspension from attending classes
- (3) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- (4) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- (5) Withholding results
- (6) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- (7) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- (8) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 semesters
- (9) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution
- (10) Fine of Rupees 25,000/-
- (11) **Collective punishment:** When the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

## Scholarships & Fee Rebates

Students from first year can avail any and all scholarships available to them. Online forms can be filled out at respective government websites. For any and all required certificates a Certificate Requisition Form has to be filled out and submitted at Room No. 13, Deans' Block.

Depending on the need and criteria help in the form of tuition rebates is offered.

- (a) The SC/ST/PH students shall get complete fee waiver.
- (b) The most economically backward students (whose family income is less than ₹1.00 lakh per annum) shall get full remission of the fee.
- (c) The other economically backward students (whose family income is between ₹1.00 lakh to ₹5.00 lakh per annum) shall get remission of 2/3rd of the fee.

## Internships and Long-Term Internships

Internships are a way of learning some really important skills that are relevant for you during your professional life out of the institute. They also help you in building contacts, setting you up for future opportunities.

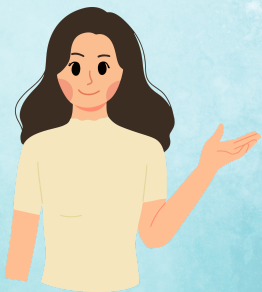
## **Minor Degree**
