Additional Criteria for Screening

Referring to Note 4 of the advertisement given by the Institute for the Faculty Recruitment vide NITMGH/ES/REC/F/Vol.IV/2024-25/1246 dated 11.09.2024, the additional criteria for screening of candidates in various departments are listed below:

A. Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering:

1. Minimum 60% or 6 CGPA marks in 10th and 12th standard.
2. Minimum 75% or 8 CGPA in UG and PG.
3. Minimum 2 SCI publications as first author.

B. Department of Electrical Engineering:

1. Minimum 60% or 6.5 CGPA in 10th class and 12th Class/Diploma.
2. Minimum 70% or 7.5 CGPA in UG degree.
3. At least Two (02) SCI/SCIE published research papers in the relevant specialization.
4. PhD must be from IIT/NIT/CFTI/Govt or institute with NIRF rank up to 100 or foreign institute QS/THE rank up to 500 on the year of PhD degree awarded.

C. Department of Mechanical Engineering:

1. Minimum 60% in 10th/HSLC and 12th/HSSLC.
2. Minimum 75% or 8.0 CGPA in BTech.
3. PhD should be from IITs/NITs/CFTIs/State Govt. funded institutions/ universities/ research labs, or Institutes/Universities with NIRF within 100 in the respective category, or reputed institutions with a World QS ranking within 500.

D. Department of Chemical and Biological Sciences:

a) For Grade-I

1. Minimum 60% in Class 10 and Class 12.
2. PhD should be from IITs/NITs/CFTIs/State Govt. funded institutions/ universities/ research labs, or Institutes/Universities with NIRF within 100 in the respective category, or reputed institutions with a World QS/THE ranking within 500.

b) For Grade-II

1. Minimum 60% in Class 10 and Class 12.
2. Minimum 70% or 7.5 CGPA in PG/ Master's Level
3. PhD should be from IITs/NITs/CFTIs/State Govt. funded institutions/ universities/ research labs, or Institutes/Universities with NIRF within 100 in the respective category, or reputed institutions with a World QS/THE ranking within 500.

E. Department of Humanities and Social Sciences:

1. Minimum 60% in Class X and Class XII.
2. PhD should be from IITs/NITs/CFTIs/State Government funded University or Institute, or Institutes/ Universities with NIRF within 100 in the respective category, or reputed institutions with a World QS Ranking within 500.
