Memorandum of Understanding
between

and
National Institute of Technology Manipur

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereafter referred to as MoU) is entered into after mutual discussions and having arrived at the consensus, for offering admission to 8 (eight) internally displaced students of the National Institutes of Technology Manipur, in the National Institutes of Technology Meghalaya; on this ~~11th~~ day of ~~July~~ of 2024; between the National Institute of Technology Meghalaya, hereinafter referred as NIT Meghalaya, having its office at Bijni Complex, Laitumkhrah, Shillong, Meghalaya which meaning also includes the address of it's permanent campus at Sohra, Cherapunjee and is represented by its Director which expression includes his successor on the first part;

And the National Institutes of Technology Manipur, hereinafter referred as NIT Manipur, having its office at Langol Rd, Lamphelpat, Imphal, Manipur 795004 and represented by its Director which expression also includes his successor, on the second part under the following terms:

Scope:

The scope of this MoU is for collaboration on academic and research activities in the following categories:

1. Academic and Research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest.
2. Exchange of academic information, Scholarly information, materials and publications based on mutual agreements for intended purposes.
3. Academic and Research Exchange of students and faculty.
4. Conducting joint seminars, workshops and other academic meetings.

Students Exchange Programme:

Pursuant to the agreement for academic exchange, NIT Meghalaya and NIT Manipur, will exchange students according to the terms and on mutual agreements. It is desired by both the parties that there will be significant flow of students in both directions based on mutual agreements including admission to 8 (eight) internally displaced students of NIT Manipur to UG Programme at NIT Meghalaya for 1(one) year. This is in line with the august order of the Apex Court in Writ Petition No. WPs 7714/2024 that was filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India by Kuki Students, Delhi.

Research Collaboration:

Faculty from both the Institutions will collaborate in the supervision of students exchanged and in joint research in disciplines of mutual interest with an intent for having deliverables for societal usage and societal benefits.






Coordinators: For the purposes of this MoU, the Coordinators from the Institutes shall be appointed from time to time, the details of which shall be shared between the parties to this MoU.

Validity: This MoU shall come into force from the date of the signature of the MoU, and shall remain in force, unless it is mutually agreed otherwise. Any Amendments to this MoU may be made only by mutual agreement in writing by the signatory parties to this MoU i.e the Directors of the Institutes.

Termination: The MoU may be terminated in writing by one of the parties giving a written notice of 6 months informing it's intention to the other party ensuring that any ongoing and scheduled activity under this MoU during that time shall not be impacted.

Dispute Resolution: Where a problem or dispute arises between the signatory parties to this MoU, the parties shall seek to resolve and settle the matter amicably by direct discussion between themselves to the best of their endeavours. **If the matter still cannot be resolved in this manner, the Directors of the Institutes shall examine the matter, and pronounce the decision; this decision shall be binding on the affected individuals .**
